NDIS community nursing services are delivered by qualified nurses and can encompass a wide range of healthcare needs. Nurses will continue to practice within their usual scope of practice.



What are the NDIS Practice Standards?

The NDIS Practice Standards set out guidelines for the quality of supports and services delivered to NDIS participants.

The NDIS Practice Standards work alongside the NDIS Code of Conduct to build awareness and set expectations for Providers.

NDIS providers are obliged to meet certain standards.

What are the Modules required to meet the NDIS Practice Standards?

The NDIS Practice Standards consist of Core, Verification, and additional modules for service providers. Compliance is assessed using quality indicators developed by the NDIS Commission, and both registered and unregistered providers must adhere to specific requirements.

What does it mean to be NDIS Compliant?

NDIS compliant means meeting criteria and regulations set by the National Disability Insurance Scheme. Key aspects include eligibility, quality standards, staff training, documentation, accountability, pricing transparency, and continuous improvement. Compliance ensures safe, quality services for people with disabilities. For registered providers, compliance is essential as it allows them to offer services to all NDIS participants. Non-compliance can lead to registration suspension or revocation.

What if I choose to work as an Unregistered Provider?

Nurses can build a thriving business with a strong client base, provided you maintain professional documentation, including compliant policies and procedure manuals and ensure you have the right insurance coverage and screening checks. Healthcare Consulting supports you to safeguard your unregistered provider venture. 

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



