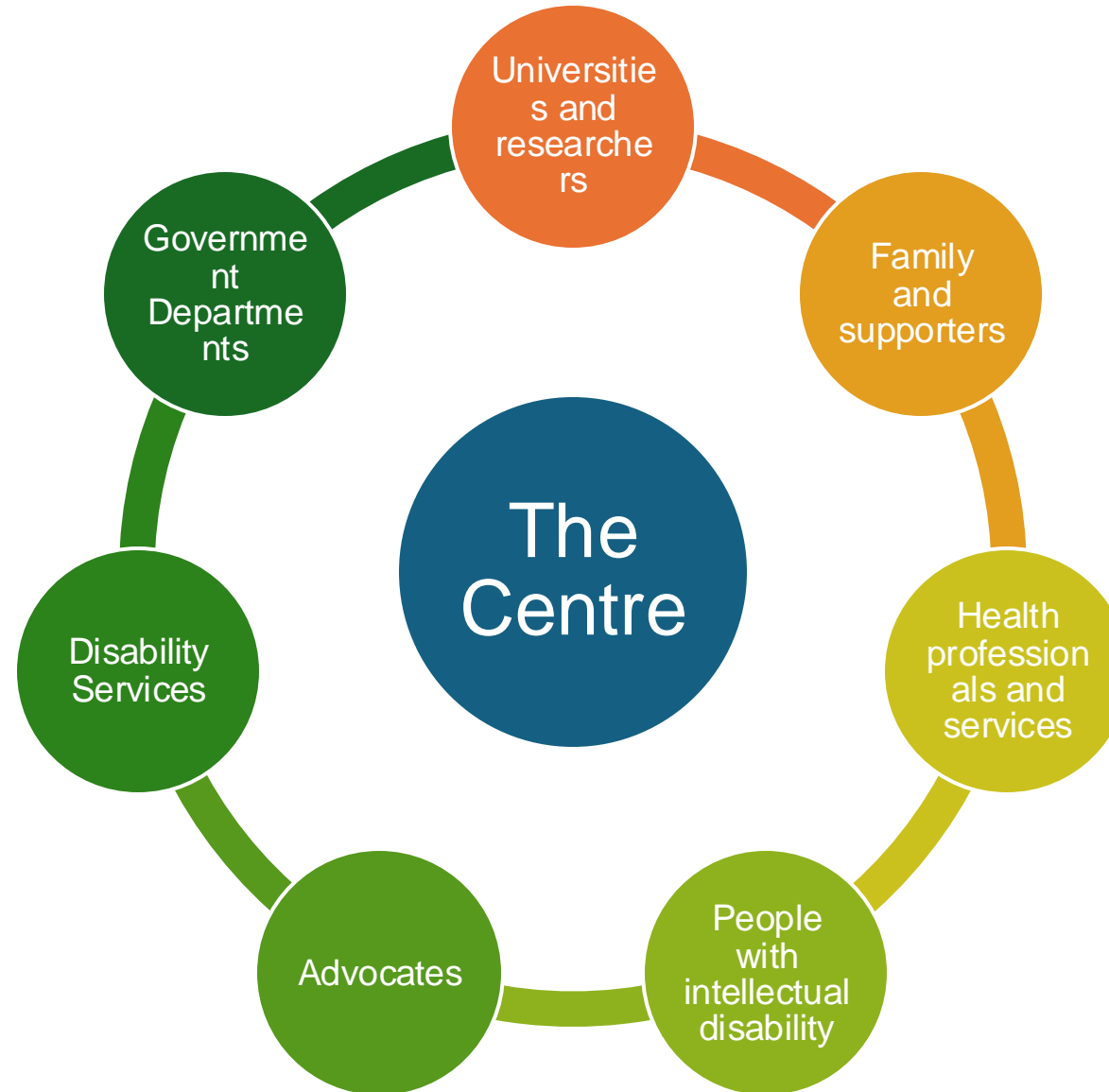

# Centre Project Teams

1. **Health Services Development Team** – Focuses on health services and models of care for people with intellectual disability
